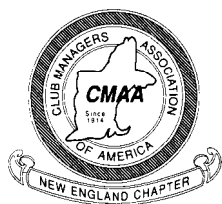

**From Boston, MA (Logan International Airport)**

Take Route 90 WEST (Mass Turnpike) Worcester via Williams Tunnel to exit 11A Interstate 495 NORTH, to Exit 27 Route 117 WEST, travel 1.7 miles and take a left onto Wilder Road. Approximately a half mile down Wilder Rd, take fork left and follow the red and white "THE INTERNATIONAL" signs another half mile to The International entrance on the right side of Ballville Road.

**From Hartford, CT**

Take Interstate 84 EAST to Interstate 90 EAST (Mass Turnpike), take Exit 10 to Interstate 290 EAST, take Exit 26B to Interstate 495 NORTH, take Exit 27 to Route 117 WEST, travel 1.7 miles and take a left onto Wilder Road. Approximately a half mile down Wilder Rd, take fork left and follow the red and white "THE INTERNATIONAL" signs another half mile to The International entrance on the right side of Ballville Road.

**From Providence, RI**

Take Interstate 95 NORTH to Exit 6B, Interstate 495 NORTH, take Exit 27 to Route 117 WEST, travel 1.7 miles and take a left onto Wilder Road. Approximately a half mile down Wilder Rd, take fork left and follow the red and white "THE INTERNATIONAL" signs another half mile to The International entrance on the right side of Ballville Road.

**From Manchester, NH**
